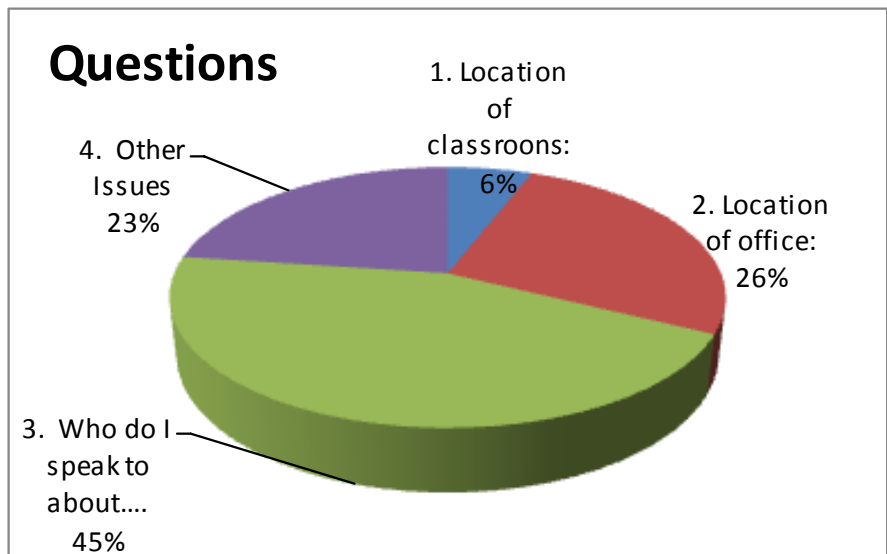
## Succeed in 4 Assessment Update



The Enrollment Management committee planned this activity to make the transition smoother for first-year students and those who were new to Worcester State. Surprisingly, there were questions from high school students who were visiting campus, seniors who wanted information about graduation procedures, and WRTA schedules.

Communication will continue through the use of campus electronic media. The library and student center scrolling screens and the Web Community System will contain up-to-date information.

We had a successful opening of school and a successful start to the Succeed in 4 initiative. Communication was identified as a key component to making a smooth transition for all students during the first ten days of the semester. Information tables were staffed in the Student Center and the Administration building, where knowledgeable members of the campus community were able to answer questions and point people in the right direction.



A total of 306 questions were fielded. Of those, 45% wanted to know who to talk to about a particular issue or concern. 36% had questions about classes., 25% wanted information about Add/Drop policies.
