	<i>Gold</i>	<i>Silver</i>	<i>Bronze</i>	<i>Tin</i>
<b>Unit Bar(s)</b>	Bar(s) are drawn with the correct number of units. <b>(5 points)</b>	Bar(s) are drawn partially correct, without the correct number of units. <b>(4 points)</b>	Bar(s) are not drawn correct, but an understanding of the bar is shown. <b>(2 points)</b>	Bar(s) are not drawn. <b>(0 points)</b>
<b>Labeling</b>	Unit bar(s) are labeled correctly, including a question mark for the unknown. <b>(5 points)</b>	Unit bar(s) are labeled correctly, no question mark for the unknown. <b>(4 points)</b>	Unit bar(s) are not labeled correctly, but an understanding of labeling is shown. <b>(2 points)</b>	Unit bar(s) are not labeled. <b>(0 points)</b>
<b>Math Work</b>	Math work is shown neatly, is labeled, and is done correctly. <b>(5 points)</b>	Math work is shown neatly, and is done correctly. <b>(4 points)</b>	Math work is shown, and is done incorrectly. <b>(2 points)</b>	Math work is not shown. <b>(0 points)</b>
<b>Answer</b>	Answer is correct and in a complete sentence. <b>(5 points)</b>	Answer is correct but is not in a complete sentence. <b>(4 points)</b>	Answer is incorrect and may or may not be in a complete sentence. <b>(2 points)</b>	Answer is not given. <b>(0 points)</b>
