Why would I sign up for a meal plan option if I have an apartment?

The time that you use to shop, plan, cook, and clean up after your meal could be used to study, spend time with your family, meet up with friends, or just have fun. By getting a meal plan, you will free up all that time to do things you enjoy.

If I don't have a lot of time to eat, should I still consider purchasing a meal plan?

Absolutely. Commuter meal plans were designed with the knowledge that commuter students don't have a lot of free time to sit down and eat a meal. That is why Chartwells offers the flexibility of meals to go and also allows you to carry over your meals from week to week.

What are the meal plan options?

You have the option of purchasing a variety of plans, which vary in price. You can purchase a Dining Dollars plan or a Block Meal plan. Dining Dollars are accepted like cash in all of the dining locations. The card works on the same principle as a debit card, which you can use for snacks, beverages, or even a meal. The Block Meal plan allows you to purchase a number of meals throughout the semester. This allows you to carry over a meal from week-to-week without having to worry about how much money you have left on your card.

Is it true that I automatically pay for a \$50 meal plan as a first-year and/or transfer student?

Yes! You are required to purchase a \$50 meal plan each semester. This is to encourage you to become part of the student community in the Student Center. If you do not use your full \$50, it will be forfeited to Chartwells at the end of the semester.

What do I need to do to sign up for a meal plan?

Visit the Chartwells Office, 3rd Floor of the Student Center, to fill out the appropriate form. Get a student ID card, with a magnetic stripe on the back, from OneCard Office.

Bring your card to the Chartwells Dining Service Office to have the card activated.

Put money on your Dining Dollars Account on your OneCard.

What if I lose my meal/OneCard?

Report it immediately to Campus Police at (508) 929-8044 and then contact the OneCard Office (in the Gym Building) to ensure that your card has not been used. The OneCard Office can issue you a new card for a \$25 fee.

What do I do if my Dining Dollars run out?

You can view your outstanding balance on your dining receipt or print out a statement from the Cash Management Center (CMC) Machine (top of the ramp, 1st Floor in the Student Center).

You can add money at the CMC machine, online or at the OneCard Office.

Do I have access to a microwave or fridge on campus?

There is also a microwave in the Food Court area and a refrigerator and microwave located in the Living Room of the Student Center (2nd floor). The refrigerator and microwave are both cleaned and maintained several times a week.
