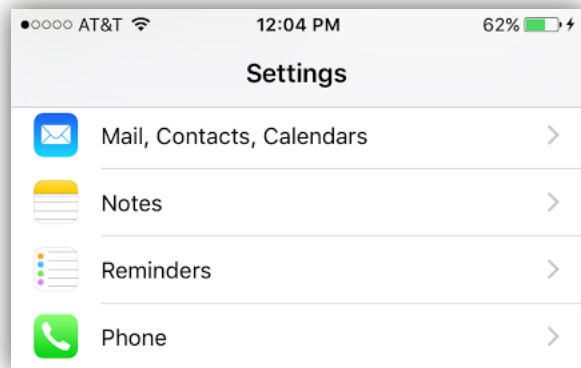


Can you hear me now? No? Having phone issues on campus?

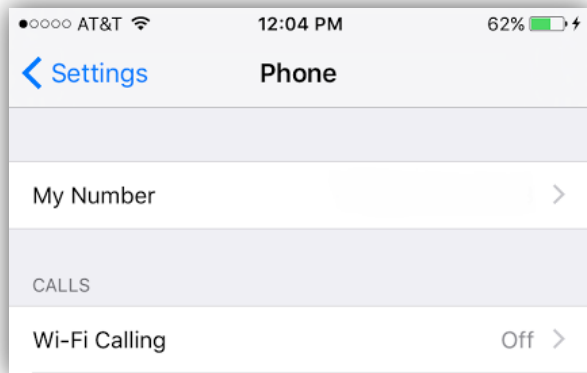

For iOS users

- 1) Go to **Settings > Phone**



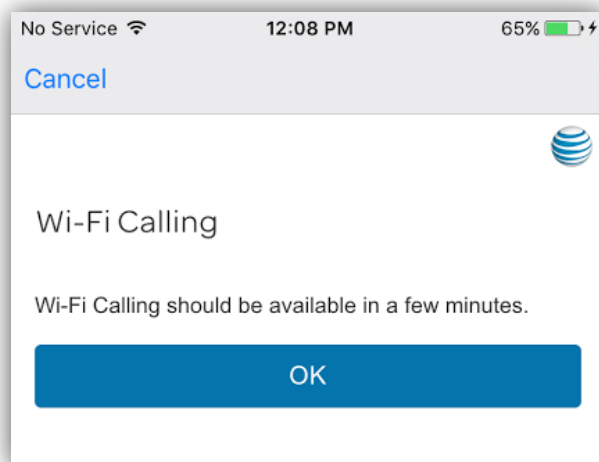
- 2) Turn on Wi-Fi Calling



- 3) It's going to tell you if you want to cancel or enable Wi-Fi calling, **click Enable**



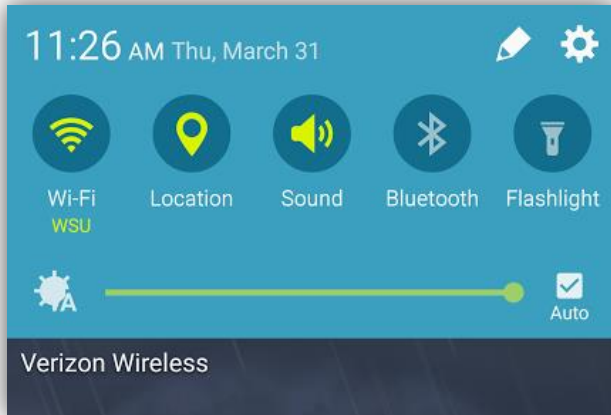
The next steps will inform you about 911 calls over Wi-Fi, and ask for an emergency address before you can proceed. Once you have accepted those terms you will get this screen.



Congratulations! You are now using Wi-Fi calling.

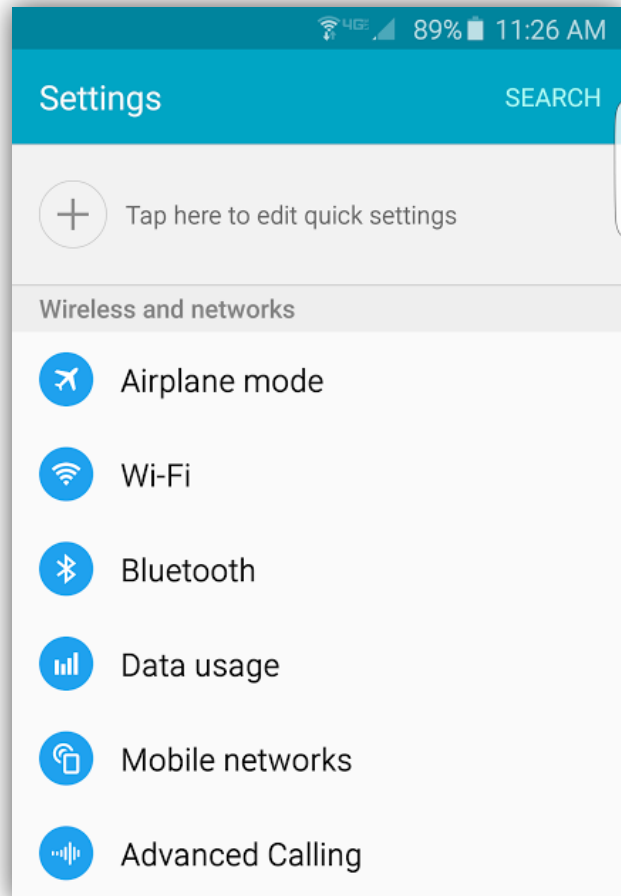
For Android users

- 1) **Swipe down** from the top of the phone and click

- 2) Next click on **Advanced Calling**.



- 3) Click **Activate Advanced Calling**
