

## Using SPSS and from home on your own computer:

(If you have Windows 7/8/10 follow these instructions)

First you must set up the VPN Access on your computer:

1. Go to: <http://apps.worcester.edu/vpn/>
2. Click and download VPN Profile
3. Once VPN Profile is downloaded, run the file.
4. Click Connect and authenticate using [username@worchester.edu](mailto:username@worchester.edu) and your WSU password. You are now CONNECTED to the WSU network from home.

Next, you must connect to “remote desktop”

1. Make sure you are connected to the WSU VPN
2. Click the button on the lower left hand corner of your screen (start button)
3. Type Remote Desktop. It will appear as an option.
4. Click Remote Desktop
5. Once Remote Desktop loads, type WSCTERM1 as the computer name and click Connect.
6. On the following screen, you will see a log in screen. Use your WSU credentials to gain access to the remote server.
7. Once logged in, click the start button in the remote environment and type SPSS. You can now use SPSS.

(If you have an Apple Computer follow these instructions)

First you must set up the VPN Access on your computer:

1. Go to: <http://apps.worcester.edu/vpn/>
2. Look under the section labeled “VPN and Remote Access for Mac”
3. Follow the video on the screen labeled “setting up VPN”

Next, Understand how to use the “remote desktop”

1. Go to: <http://apps.worcester.edu/vpn/>
2. Look under the section labeled “VPN and Remote Access for Mac”
3. Follow the video on the screen labeled “Setting up Remote Software for Mac”
5. Once you have installed Remote Desktop, you can find it located under Applications on your Mac
6. Make sure you are connected to the WSU VPN
7. Click Remote Desktop
8. Once Remote Desktop loads, type WSCTERM1 as the computer name and click Connect
9. On the following screen, you will see a log in screen. Use your WSU credentials to gain access to the remote server.
10. On the top of the screen, select View and click Full Screen.
11. Once logged in, click the start button in the remote environment and type SPSS. You can now use SPSS.
