- Booths are 10' wide x 8' deep (6' tables without picture rail are available upon request, but you are responsible for all other equipment needed for a professional booth set up.

Please notify Candace Casey (CCasey4@worchester.edu)with your preference, all booths and tables are assigned on a first come, first serve basis. Artists must attend their booths/tables. No substitutions unless approved by Candace Casey by September 18th, 2020.

Security: Tower Hill will be providing overnight security for the duration of the fair.

Important Dates:

Application Deadline: March 1, 2020 \$200.00 non-refundable deposit due with your application

Acceptance Deadline: March 15, 2020

Balance Due Date: June 15, 2020

Important Note:

Your signed application form implies a contract with The Worcester Center for Crafts affirming that you are ready, willing and able to participate in the event. A deposit of \$200 must accompany your application or the application will not be accepted. If your application is not accepted, your \$200 deposit will be refunded.

Cancellation Policy:

Notice of your intention to withdraw from an event, and requests for refunds, must be in writing and postmarked according to the dates below. Please confirm with WCC that your fax, email or letter has been received, since none of these methods have proven 100% reliable. If you pay by check, refunds will be issued after your payment has cleared. If you pay by credit card your refund will be credited, when applicable.

Cancellation **by or on July 1, 2020** – any payment in excess of the \$200 deposit will be returned; forfeit \$200.00 deposit.

Cancellation **after July 1, 2020** – NO REFUNDS; booth fee becomes non-refundable.
